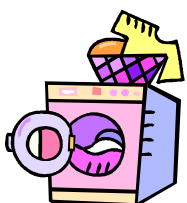

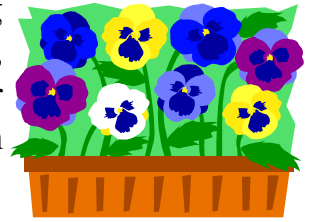
## SICK BAY LINEN

# Raising Resilient Children

## Positive Parenting Program

***Presented by Elise Stumbles, Consultant Psychologist, The Spastic Centre***

One of the most important tasks of parenthood is helping children learn to deal with their emotions. Emotional resilience refers to the ability to manage and cope with day-to-day stresses as well as major life events. This seminar offers parents a detailed outline of some of the key building blocks for developing emotional resilience including:

- \* Recognising and accepting feelings
- \* Expressing feelings appropriately
  - \* Developing coping skills
- \* Dealing with negative feelings.
